

Position Title: Sr. Marine Electronics Technician

Classification: Shop/Tech

Position Summary:

Responsible for overseeing and executing the installation of marine electronics, troubleshooting faulty marine electronic equipment, conducting surveys of existing electrical systems and reporting findings for accurate estimates to be given to customers for repair or replacement of their marine electrical equipment. Perform evaluation of new client's boats and electronics for refits or initial new installations.

Primary Activities and Responsibilities:

- Installation and troubleshooting of Marine electronics on both 24 and 12 VDC electrical systems.
- Installation and troubleshooting of 110 and 220VAC shore power systems.
- Installation and troubleshooting of communications systems, including VHF radios, satellite radio and television systems.
- Installation and troubleshooting Ethernet, NMEA 2000 and NMEA 0183 systems.
- Understanding and familiarity of NMEA 0400 installation standards
- Installation of new Marine electronics and associated wiring to NMEA and ABYC standards.
- Communication skills with customers and be able to discuss changes and issues that may arise during the installation.
- Maintain composure even when faced with challenging situations.
- Possess the skills to work with customers to assist in the layout of their Marine Electronics on their boats, and make recommendations based on the intended use of the boat. (ie: fishing, recreational, live aboard etc)
- Have experience in the use of small hand tools and various electronic test equipment. Use of a Table saw or more technical tools a plus.
- Be responsible for other technical personnel & their training.
- Continuation of education with classes as available
- Maintain good records of time on the job for each job.
- Abide by all company rules and maintain a professional appearance.
- Communication with office personnel for compiling an estimate OR completion of an invoice, after leaving a customer's boat or job.

Minimum Qualifications:

- High School graduate or equivalency
- Associates degree in electronics or electrical engineering
- Thorough understanding of AC and DC systems
- 3 - 5 years of Marine Electronics installation experience.
- NMEA MEI certificate
- 2 or more years of experience leading or managing complex projects

Preferred Qualifications:

In addition to meeting the above qualifications, any of the following are preferred:

- Bachelor's degree from an accredited University preferred
- 4 or more years of supervisory experience
- NMEA AMEI certificate
- ABYC Marine Electrical Certification

Job Requirements:

- Typical work hours M-F, 8am-5pm. Evening and weekend work as required based on project schedules
